


TIMELINE OF COAL ASH AT BROADHURST LANDFILL



A look at the timeline of the history of coal ash at the Broadhurst Landfill shows that much of what Republic Services did with coal ash was carried out without public notice. They never informed the citizens that: 1) they brought in 800,000 tons of toxic coal ash over an eight year period; 2) they had a spill that contaminated groundwater with dangerous heavy metals; 3) they applied to build a rail spur to bring in 10,000 tons of coal ash per day; 4) 5 years after the spill, the groundwater still tests high in several coal ash contaminants. ***If you want better coal ash laws to protect Georgians from toxic coal ash, please contact your legislators.***
